

'PLAY ME, I'M YOURS'

Luke Jerram

Luke Jerram's workspace at Paintworks in Bristol is calm and quiet despite the pressures of working on so many projects at once. Two people are busy painting *Mars*, constantly checking the templates for the colour and craters that are laid out on the floor. In another unit a deflated *Gaia* is suspended from the ceiling, its fabric trailing across the floor. Once transported to a particular location these, and there a quite a few of them, are inflated and measure seven metres across. Most recently one has been installed in Wells Cathedral.

As a student studying Sculpture and Performance at Cardiff watching someone on stage, Jerram came to the conclusion that the performer was getting more out of their performance than the audience. He decided that he wanted to turn this around and make sure that it was the public who were getting the most out of the experience. This idea manifested itself in the street piano project. Its aim was to place the members of the audience centre stage as performers themselves.

Luke draws people together, quietly encouraging them to move out of their comfort zone and take part, to get involved. *Play Me, I'm Yours*, his street piano project does exactly that. Pianos sitting in a station forecourt or on a street corner invite people to play them. They are quite simply irresistible and passers-by, who would never dream of playing in public or performing in front of an audience, are seduced by the apparent abandoned availability of these musical instruments. They sit down to play anything from chopsticks to a Beethoven Sonata.

It is quite magical. People take ownership. To date Jerram has overseen the installation of over 2000 pianos worldwide and it has sparked a global movement with places picking up the project and installing pianos in public. Luke has no problem with his idea being hijacked, for him the proof of a good idea is that people take it and make it their own.

Streetpianos.com holds a special place in Luke's heart because of the many lovely stories that arose from it. People met and got married, others got licenses for music events and musicians were offered recording contracts. Jerram clearly delights in listening to and sharing those stories and other anecdotes arising from or contained within his works. Another sharing of stories is part of his installation *Crossings* which is a collaboration with BBC Radio4 producer Julian May. Nine rowing boats were floated on the lake at Compton Verney in Warwickshire and visitors could row the boats out onto the lake and select an audio 'story' from around the world to listen to.

Two of Luke Jerram's artworks are currently on show at the Royal West of England Academy in Bristol. *Clothed with Protection* is a video of a project in Kampala in Uganda. Ten fashion designers were commissioned to design clothes that would promote Covid vaccination for pregnant women throughout Africa.


The second artwork at RWA Bristol is his *Covid* 19 glass sculpture. Since 2004 Jerram has been working with glass microbiology. Scale is very important to him, hence the scaling up of viruses by a million times into beautiful complex glass sculptures. He has collaborated with glassblowers Brian Jones and Norman Veitch to make increasingly challenging larger forms. There is an exquisite irony that these beautiful objects represent something so deadly.

The thread that connects all of Jerram's projects is collaboration. He not only works across disciplines, he collaborates with musicians, scientists, manufacturers and others. He harnesses the wind, the sun, changing weather patterns and tides to make his art works. Sound is a vital element for many of them and he often commissions composers to write new music for him inviting them to incorporate sounds from the natural world. It is another form of collaboration and crisscrossing of boundaries.

Active participation is another vital ingredient. His work requires an audience and participation to make the artwork come alive. He puts people at the centre of his practice and his works bring communities together. That participatory, performative aspect is part of his personal language as an artist.





spectacular seasonal show in their multi studio site opposite the vintage railway station.

THE THELMA HULBERT GALLERY in Honiton houses a permanent collection of the artist's work, as well as hosting contemporary art and craft exhibitions. *Present Makers* has been running for the last 15 years and is a leading annual selling exhibition in the UK craft calendar. This year's theme is nature, and focusses on jewellery and ceramic collections, as well as showcasing emergent makers.

In Salisbury you'll find FISHERTON MILL, the largest independent arts complex in the south-west. It's always worth a visit, but especially at Christmas when all is bright and sparkling. Their Christmas exhibition entitled *Not Just Camels...* is again an eclectic collective show. They launch their festive season on 11 November with a shopping evening accompanied by mulled wine, seasonal snacks and live music.

This gallery and shop in a pretty courtyard setting always has a full programme. The deadline for open entries is not until 28 November, so for the creatives amongst you there's still time to submit work!

Filled with the work of a huge selection of artists, it is the perfect opportunity to view work by established and emerging artists at this, very much community orientated, gallery in Glastonbury. This established collective always produce a quality show, celebrating colour, surface and composition in a mix of mediums, this exhibition *Connections* is no exception. There is also an excellent Makers gift shop, café and artists' studios onsite.

LANACRE BARN GALLERY in the heart of Exmoor opens its Christmas show on 19 November. A celebration of the Moor in many mediums, this exhibition features work by Slade schooled fine artists, jewellers, printmakers and photographers, as well as slipware ceramics in their north Devon origins. There are refreshments on offer for those that venture that way.

Established makers Rose Hatcher and Kate Osman's annual exhibition *Handmade for Christmas* is a down-to-earth, honest approach to collaborative exhibiting, featuring 70 guest makers from Dorset and the surrounding counties. The last ten years has seen the show grow in both size and confidence, every square inch of space is utilised with ingenious display ensembles, it is quite literally filled to the rafters and the antithesis of a white cube space.



The Monochrome Set

"The Monochrome Set formed in 1978, and were heavily influential in the 'post-punk' scene that evolved after the initial scorched earth of punk. The band's early releases were on the legendary Rough Trade Label before signing with Virgin offshoot Din Disc. They also released several albums on the Cherry Red label, making a notable appearance on that label's well known Pillows and Prayers compilation. Though they split in 1985 the next decade saw several reunions for both live gigs and further studio recordings. After a hiatus of over a decade the band reformed full time in 2010 and have since toured all over the UK, Europe, Japan and the USA, whilst also releasing seven new, critically acclaimed, studio albums. 




