


Exhibit A Ursula Leach: High Hedge


Oil on Canvas, 60 x 60 cm

ARTIST'S STATEMENT: "Last year in a national newspaper I saw a photograph of a large hedge in Dorset. The adjoining article was asking for volunteers to help survey hedges for the *Great Big Dorset Hedge* initiative. The results are then relayed to farmers who could then make good their hedges from the findings and maybe get a grant. Hedges are important as corridors and food for wildlife and insects, also they are barriers against flooding and soil erosion. So I volunteered and the project for my next one person exhibition was born. I have always been interested in what is happening on the land, particularly agricultural land. Now I focussed on hedges and having made drawings, colour notes and taken photographs on the motif I move these observations into paintings and prints in the studio to express distinctive aspects of particular hedges in their setting. The canvas provides a forum for investigating pictorial space creating a dialogue between interior and edge. It is the formal aspects of image making that really engage me, space, shape and particularly colour. Colour is used in a way that is non-literal. Placing colours one against the other is intended to evoke a parallel to the atmosphere of the subject (landscape) however different that colour is from reality. By radical editing and simplification of colour, shape and composition I hope to stimulate a direct reaction in the audience."

Housework at The Sherborne

Sherborne House is remembered by many as a leading contemporary art space in the heart of Sherborne - a venue that brought the likes of Gavin Turk to rural Dorset and encouraged artists to respond to the space rather than just exhibit in it. Curated initially by artist led group Sherborne Contemporary Arts (SCA), and later by Sherborne House Arts (SHA) the house provided a much needed exhibiting and meeting space.

Some of the work produced was intrinsically linked to the house's previous incarnations, as a private home and then a girls' school, woven together to produce an eclectic vision of past and present. Not only did Sherborne House Arts produce a diverse range of exhibitions and activity but it was also the catalyst for collaborative artistic and curatorial activity within the county. SHA launched collectives such as Big Picture and Ex Lab, and organisations that have emerged from this include bside and Evolver Magazine.

After a hiatus in activity and an extraordinary amount of restoration work Housework is the first exhibition to be shown at Sherborne House now it has fully reopened. Marrying commercial activity with creative, to secure a sustainable future. The Sherborne has chosen Dorset Visual Arts (DVA) as its creative partner to plan a full programme of exhibitions and events. DVA will re-establish the house as a venue of regional and international import in the art world, with thriving educational and community arts programmes running alongside rotating exhibitions and high-end work by artists and makers.

We cannot underestimate the importance of what happened here during these years, and this exhibition, curated by artist Amanda Wallwork in association with Evolver Magazine, seeks to recognise the role the house played as well as a chance to show some of the works created in response to the building over the years.

Evolver Magazine has had a longstanding relationship with Sherborne House and we are delighted to play a part in making this exhibition happen.



First up for this new Sound of Wessex column is a mystery delivery by none other than our very own Mr Simon Barber. Simon excitedly dropped off a test pressing at the shop this week. Who doesn't love a test pressing? Shiny new and with the promise of untold riches, and this was no disappointment. The white labelled seven inch housed in matching sleeve contained the new single by **i-nichi**. and what a single it is! i-nichi is primarily Tokvo-based but Wessex-active singer songwriter Seiko Nemoto, whose name has been bandied about by my good friend Adam for some time now. This is the first opportunity for me to check out a studio recording by Seiko, joined by multi instrumentalist Philip Collings. The EP contains three great tracks Mimiko, Richard Sinclair and Dear Mr. David Shrigley, three of the most charming indie / alternative tracks you're likely to hear this year. A beautiful EP recorded at Axe & Trap studios in Wells by Ben Turner will be released on Spinout Nuggets on Friday 31st May on limited edition yellow vinyl. To celebrate the release Seiko will be performing a selection of tracks at Clocktower Records in Bridport, see bridportandwestbay.co.uk for all the important details.

Wessex's finest purveyors of electronica and modular ambience **Twilight Sequence** are set to play the Acid Horse festival in Pewsey (24 - 26 May). This is in build up to the much anticipated second album due to be released on the Castles in Space label later in the year. The outfit also play at Images in Plymouth on Friday 28th June with Ubiquitous Meh! and Luminous Foundation, a line-up not to be missed!

Bristol based band Make Friends have released the first single from their upcoming EP. Produced by Ed Nash (of Bombay Bicycle Club fame), Loaded Fun sees the band continue their growth into a fine indie rock band, providing fans with fantastic upbeat grooves and emotive, thought provoking lyrics about the ups and downs of life. 


